Report on orientation programme for teachers

Empowering Teachers is the key to Enhancing Education

Date 20/6/2019-22/6/2019

Greatest asset in the society is teachers. Teachers play important role in the lives of students. Teachers have ability to inspire, empower and foster environments of self-confidence, passion and nurturance or the complete opposite. College of Education under the guidance of Principal Prof.M.P.Patil and IQAC coordinator Dr.Rajani Sonawane organized an eventful and enriching orientation programme for the teachers and students from 20/6/2019 to 22/6/2019. Teacher orientation is important to lay a foundation for the teachers, mainly to provide them with concise and accurate information about the how system of programme run to make them more comfortable in their teaching tenure. Orientation encourages the teacher's confidence and helps them to adopt the teaching environment.

The main focus of the teachers orientation programme was to communicate the various programme learning outcomes (PLOs) and course learning outcomes (CLOs) for all the courses that are offered by CEC . The orientation adopted strategies and methods that were participatory, discussion and activity based in order to enable the teachers to think, reflect and critically analyze the ideas/aspect and the method followed. Details of the programmes are as given

On first day (20/6/2019)

Teachers interacted with resource person DR.P.P.Chaudhari Principal .college of Education Amalner. He shared new innovative ways with the teachers and suggested guidelines to perform them in a direction to achieve stated PLOs and CLOs in B.Ed curriculum.

On second day (21/6/2019)

To enable teachers to conduct better and get geared up for the academic session (2019-2020) the entire teaching staff and students was given presentation by the Principal on PLOs and CLOs of B.Ed curriculum. He also discussed the various strategies that have to be followed for achieving these objectives.

On third day (22/6/2019)

To make interaction possible among the teachers, a faculty presentation session was planned. It was a great exposure for the teachers. They presented ideas about the differ

options of teaching they can use with the students. Mr.Rajeesh Balan was the resource person

Faculty in higher education normally join the teaching profession without any formal training in teaching, learning or classroom management. Thus, the training is required as essential eligibility criteria for their appointment. In order to ensure qualitative growth of education faculty need to be strengthened and their ongoing professional development need to be given due attention. This demands a compulsory induction programme for freshly recruited faculty in colleges. Internal Quality Assurance Cell, of College of Education Chopda organized a Faculty Induction Programme to refresh the faculty and familiarize the effective academic practices to be followed in the academics. Objectives of the Programme

- To enable the faculty to understand their roles and responsibilities in Higher Education and to impart essential professional skills, competencies and attitudes.
- To help the participants to understand the structure, functioning, governance, rules and regulations of the Institution and to orient them to become potential partners of institute.
- To explain and motivate the faculty to adopt learner centric approaches of teaching and classroom management.
- To enable the faculty, to develop & understand various methods of evaluation and assessment

To enable the faculty to familiarize the distinctions of curricular reforms, curriculum design and development in university and college in the context of inter-disciplinarity, with specific reference to CBCS.

- To empower the faculty to get familiar and adopt with ICT integrated learning and new educational approaches to teaching learning.
- To orient the faculty with the process of generating new learning materials for enrichment of online open access platforms
- To provide research orientation to young faculty towards integrating research with pedagogy and innovative classroom practices.
- To sensitize and acquaint faculty with practical knowledge in emotional balance of self and student-counselling and mentoring.
- To provide knowledge about different models of leadership to the participants in order to enhance their academic leadership skills.
- To enable the faculty to learn the principles of strategic planning and management.

Duration In order to complete all the modules, the entire programme was held from 20th June to 22nd June 2019 at College of Education Chopda

. Day 1

Inauguration With the blessings of Almighty and support of Management, the programme was inaugurated by Hon Smt Madhuri Mayur Secretory Chopda Education Society, Principal of College of Education Chopda,, IQAC Coordinator and Assistant Professor, welcomed the gathering. Module 1: Higher Education and its Ecosystem

The module1 Higher Education and its Ecosystem It was presented by Dr.P.P.Chaudhari, Principal, NPS College of Education Amalner. In this session he explained and motivated faculty regarding their role and contribution of college to higher educational sector. First, she shared about the history of college and milestones of the institution and management. She pointed that college can help in great deal to produce leadership in all sphere. He described the academic and Non – academic role of teachers in college. She provided effective method of transacting /disseminating knowledge to the teachers. She imparted the faculty members about the professional training which enhance their essential competencies, skills and attitudes. She mentioned the importance of human values and also the importance of spirituality, medication in our daily life which will provoke and help the faculty to improve their patience to handle student community. He explained faculty members about the current challenges and opportunities in higher education implication for everyday classroom. He also described about NAAC, ISO, UGC 2(f) and 12(B) accreditation of college. He insisted the faculty to know how to address the problems of the students and constructive approach towards teaching and support for students learning. He also mentioned about the code of conduct, professional ethics, professional relationship and network to faculty members. He concluded her speech with institutional planning of the education and development.

Day 2

Module 2: Personal-Emotional Development and Counselling This session was presented by Dr.Anjali Joshi, Vice principal & Head, Department of NPS college of Education Amalner. She started her speech about personality development of the faculty members with specific behavioural tendencies. She stated that faculty members have to understand themselves and colleagues which will make the working environment more creative and cohesive. She explained about need of understanding student's community like socioeconomic status of students, thinking and learning capacity of the students. She also discussed how to make adjustments with academics, cultural, financial, emotional, social and intellectual to develop their self-regulatory behaviours. She insisted faculty members to understand the stress of the students and its impact at different levels. She

shared many ideas to faculty members regarding, how to reduce their stress and how to balance their family and teaching career. She trained faculty members how to counsel students and what are all the strategies should use during counselling for better personal and class adjustments.

Module 3: Strategic Planning and Management Third session was presented by Dr.Anjali Joshi , Vice principal and Head, Department NPS college of Education. She deliberated her speech on stress and time management and highlighted the importance of guidance to identify the strengths and weakness of the individuals and at the same time work on their strengths and area of interest to do wonder in future. She also motivated the faculty members to understand the decentralized planning, democratized planning and perspective planning which help them in envisioning their future.

Module 4: Environmental consciousness & Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) Fourth session was presented by P.P. Chaudhari Principal NPS college of Education. In his key note address she insisted the role of faculty members in environmental consciousness and sustainable development goals for a future society. He tagged faculty members to identify their critical role in the march of nation towards attaining sustainable development goals; also, she motivated the faculty members to realize their role by appropriately integrating sustainable development goals into their teaching and research. He described about the role of teaching faculty and higher education institution in supporting Nation to attain SDG and also necessity of SDG for a better society. He also advised the faculty members to understand the importance of their role in developing SDG towards student's community, which will help the society towards environmental consciousness.

Day 3

Module 5: Technology for Teaching and assessment of I – Generation This session was taken by Mr.Rajeesh Balan Principal English Medium Chopda. He started her speech by giving brief ideas regarding the online learning applications and system. In her address she mainly conversed about the Learning Management system, multimedia based interactive tutorial, web-based lectures, e-books, virtual class, open educational resources delivered over network based electronic devices. He also discussed on educational resources as e-pathusala, MOOCs, Mobile apps, etc., she emphasised on sensitive issues in e-content development which need direct attention and resolution, like factual accuracy and compliance, resources for information etc.

Module 6: Teaching, Learning and assessment This session was presented by Mr.Rajeesh Balan Principal English Medium School Chopda. In his speech she motivated the faculty members to understand the realm of teaching. She mentioned about the role, appropriate use and blending of technology in teaching. He insisted the strategies of teaching, in that she mentioned about the teachercentred their strengths and limitations. He discussed about the lesson planning with basic idea, logic and different types, skills and techniques for writing lesson plans. He mentioned about the effective classrooms with time management, use of humour in teaching, balancing firmness and friendliness, multicultural classrooms and inclusive educations. He discussed about the concept of learning, perspectives of learning. He also insisted the faculty members to understand the students and their needs, how to act a mentor to student group. He concluded her speech by explaining how to evaluate and assess the students in their learning outcomes. And student-centred;

Module7: Constitutional values, Human Rights and Fundamental Duties This session was explained by Mr.Rajeesh Balan Principal English Medium School Chopda.. In this she mentioned about the relationship between constitutional values and education. Then she mentioned about the human rights and fundamental duties of faculty members for the implications of right teaching, learning and research. She discussed about the role of education in creating a social justice, looking beyond stereotypical generalizations by learning respect and Faculty Induction Programme tolerance. She discussed about importance of universal values with truth, righteous conduct, peace and non – violence. She discussed about the professional ethics also.

Admission for B.Ed. Course :

• Payment of Fees :
