

Deshpande's own personal efforts were also crucial in the establishment of an independent department of geography at the University of Bombay. He raised the question of founding an All-India geographical Organization, and efforts in that direction led to the establishment of the National Association of Geographers, India.

The Students of education prepared a lecture on the Significance of the day and need to study Geography.

A Seminar Geo- Spark was also organized for the teachers of the college as well as others who participated. The seminar was conducted by Dr. Savita Jadhav. The resource person
