For this purpose, he gathered ideas from the principal centres of geographical teaching and research in the United Kingdom. Deshpande made vigorous efforts for the teaching of geography in schools and colleges in Maharashtra. He laid particular stress on the nature of the subject. Deshpande's own personal efforts were also crucial in the establishment of an independent department of geography at the University of Bombay. He raised the question of founding an All-India geographical Organization, and efforts in that direction led to the establishment of the National Association of Geographers, India.

The Students of education prepared a lecture on the Significance of the day and need to study Geography.

A Seminar Geo- Spark was also organized for the teachers of the college as well as others who participated. The seminar was conducted by Dr. Savita Jadhav. The resource person
