Feedback Analysis Report

Introduction and Objectives:

College of Education Chopda was established in the year 1990. The college aims at the overall development of the students to become entrepreneurs and professionals in the respective disciplines. Every year a survey was conducted to assess the satisfaction of all the stakeholders (Students, Parents, Alumni, Teachers, and Employers) regarding curriculum of the college. The college is permanently affiliated to KBC North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon and follow curriculum prescribed by university. Receiving positive or negative feedback from these stakeholders is important as both these are crucial in helping monitor and evaluate the provision. Listening to what stakeholder say is a contributing factor to running a successful college or institution.

Methodology

In every academic year, we ask all the stakeholders to fill a feedback form which is made available on college website too. Every year data was collected during the period 1st March to 20th March. Filling of feedback is voluntary.

For the academic year 2022-23, there were 100 registered students at the college. One hundred (100) students, 50 parents, 80 alumni, 5 teachers and 10 employers responded to the survey. The analyses presented in this report are based on the responses of these stakeholders to the survey.

Design of Feedback

The responses from the parents are collected on the two-point scale

- 1) Yes
- 2) No

The responses from the students, teachers, alumni and employers are collected on the five-point Likert scale.

- 1) Strongly Agree
- 2) Agree
- 3) Neutral
- 4) Disagree
- 5) Strongly Disagree

Feedback was collected and analyzed by Feedback Analysis Committee of the college. Opinion of all stakeholders are obtained about each parameter in percentage.

Student Feedback

The respondent sample is broadly representative of the student population with respect to gender, programme level and course. We have received 50 students' feedback on the syllabus of various programmes designed by KBC North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon. There are 35 female and 15 male respondents in the survey sample.
