### \* <u>Process of Addressing the Students Diversities</u>

### 1. Mentoring / Academic Counseling:

With the support of IQAC, Principal and along with concerned subject teacher's mentorship system is implemented in the college. During the second week of the commencement of academic session, Principal prepares the list of mentees along with the help of IQAC and the same is communicated to every mentor. Principal educates every teacher about the concept of mentorship. Similarly, is mentee also, well informed about their mentor. The main aim of mentorship involves in promoting and encouraging academically competent mentees to enhance the learning levels and be competent to continue higher education. To keep the progression, the concerned semester continuous evaluation of the mentee is done. And mentees are provided sufficient learning resources, self-employment and placements. In order to establish better and effective mentee teacher relationship and guide the mentees in academic matters, mentor system has been introduced. Every teacher work as mentor to the mentees allotted to them. For the guidance, the mentees will have to go and meet the respective mentors at least once in a week for guidance. Thus, it has become a regular activity till the end of academic year. Mentees are advised for higher studies along with proper guidance during the last semester of study.

### Role and Responsibility:

Some of the responsibilities entrusted mentors are

- (a) monitor the mentees regularity and discipline.
- (b) Identify the strengths and weakness of the mentee.

(c) Council the respective mentee once in a week to solve their problems across during their course of study.

(d) Resolve day to day academic problems of the mentee.

- (e) Guide and motivate to improve their semester end result.
- (f) Taking feedback at the end of the Mentor: Mentee procedures.
- (g) Know their academic and psychological needs and guide them accordingly.
- (h) Providing additional study materials.

### **MENTOR-MENTEEACTIVITIES**

B.Ed. programmes cannot fully become functional and meaningful without thetimely guidance, counselling and interventions by the mentors. Hence after orientation to every activity it is followed by a mentor-mentee interaction to ensure the students arecomfortable and confident to implement the planned schedule. The following areas arepositivelyconsideredforthementor-menteemeeting.

• **Introduction Session:** A mentor-mentee meeting is scheduled in the timetable. Mentorsmeet the mentees and introduce each other. Everyone gets to know each other's qualities, and needs. The mentors share their contact details and the students are ensured of their availability whenever needed.



- **RemedialTeaching:**Everyindividualstudentisgivenfeedbackontheiracademicperformance s (essays, class tests, assignments). If needed the students are provided withremedialteachingin therevision classes as scheduled in the timetable.
- **PreparationofUniversityExams:**OrientationsessionisconductedbeforetheUniversityexa minationtofamiliarizethestudentstothepaperpattern,styleofwriting,distributionofmarks for the questions, distribution of timing etc. It is discussed in small groups so thatthestudents haveenoughclarityon theevaluation system in the B.Ed.&M.Ed.course.





• Introduction to Community Centers: The mentors take charge of community work atonecenter, and introduce the students to the incharge there. They assist them enterest oget familia rwith the inmates at the center and carry out the activities there. The mentors also counsel the student to the incharge the student to the student the student to th

### • Dealing with Technology:

A few students are apprehensive to use technology as they have never done it before. Thementors help their mentees to get familiar with using the computers and encourage themtopursueshortcourseswhich willhelpthemlearnthebasicsrequiredforonlineteachinglearning.





• **Developing Communication skills:** Activities such as 'Object-talk', one minute speech,self-introduction etc. are conducted in thementor-mentee groups to develop fluency inspeaking and help the students to do away with the fear of public speaking. Discussionsbasedon the Critical thinkingactivities arealso taken up in groups.





• **Research Guidance:** At the B.Ed I. level, most of the students are new to Research. Thementorsguidetheirmenteestochooseanappropriatetopic,conductandwriteareport for Action Research. The same is done at the B.Ed II level with more depth and the students are prepared to complete their dissertation. A few students who are well versed with theprocessarefurther trainedto writeresearchpapers and also presentthem. • **Internship:** Prior to the on set of teaching skills presentation and after the general orientation the mentees are briefed once again by the mentors about the procedural aspectand provides clarification of doubts if any. The mentees are counselled before the start of internship and required guidance is provided. The mentees are free to call their mentors whenever required during the course of the internship.
