

1.Paticipation of Low- Cost Teaching Aids

One-day Workshop on

Low-cost Teaching Aids Making

Chopda Education Society's College of Education, Chopda in association with Pratap Vidya Mandir English Medium School organized a workshop on low-cost teaching aids for I Year & II Year B.Ed. Student Teachers on 22nd July 2022 at College of Education Campus. The main idea was to discuss the facts that low-cost teaching aids are an effective tool as it helps to understand various complex scientific principles in an easy way.

Resource Persons from Pratap Vidya Mandir English Medium School, Chopda emphasized the need to inculcate passion amongst students for science by making classroom teaching more interactive and enjoyable through use of low-cost teaching kits. Tools were designed to engage students through hands on activities for faster learning, discourage cramming and make the subject interesting for them. Further, studies have suggested that students remember 90 percent of what they do and are demonstrated through the medium of science communication.

The participants during the workshops were trained to make easy to use low- cost teaching kits in classroom, which could help in improving conceptual understanding and promoting creativity among students. The student teachers showed keen interest in the workshop and prepared their own low-cost teaching kits demonstrating various scientific principles.

Orientation on Pratap Vidya Mandir English Medium School, Chopda activities for school and college students were given. Significance of P V M English Medium's Outreach Programs were also emphasized.

Students also visited the science lab which was stationed at the campus and the volunteers demonstrated different teaching aids for the student teachers.

Outcomes:

Student teachers gained an idea about designing low-cost teaching aids for their classrooms. These teaching aids can be used in their respective internship schools. They were oriented that the concepts taught using interactive materials and teaching aids will enhance the conceptual understanding of students in schools.

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2. Introduction to Outcome Based Education (OBE)

Outcome-Based Education (OBE) is an educational approach and a learning philosophy, focusing and organizing the entire academic programs (curriculum) and instructional efforts around clearly defined 'outcomes' that an institution wants all students to demonstrate when they complete the program. It is a student-centered instruction model that focuses on measuring student performances through outcomes. The OBE model helps faculty members to plan the course delivery and assessment with the end point in mind which has been implemented to attribute the various outcomes like program specific outcome (PO) and course outcome (CO), it remains the base and tools used to measure the student-teachers performance. It mainly requires the active participation of teachers in the departments, since it needs to develop an effective teaching and assessment method which helps to capture both the learning and performance of the learners.




1. Book Reading Practices and Discussion



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2. Preservation and Conservation of Books






<u>1. Discussion on ''National Education Policy 2020:</u> <u>Opportunities and Challenges in Teacher Education''</u>

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


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


2. Online Interaction Session on "SAMVAD"
