Report on Constitution Day

Date: 26 November 2021

The celebration of Constitution Day at College of Education Chopda on November 26, 2021, aimed to commemorate the adoption of the Indian Constitution, promote awareness of its historical significance, and educate the college community about the role of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar and the drafting of the Constitution.

Objective:

The objectives of the event were:

- To recall and honor the Indian Constitution's adoption and its visionary architect, Dr. B.R. Ambedkar.
- Raise awareness and comprehension of the historical significance of the Indian Constitution within the campus community.
- Involve faculty and student-teachers in conversations regarding the content and framing of the Constitution, emphasizing its importance in forming the nation.

Description of the Program:

The Constitution Day program began at 3:00 PM with a prayer song dedicated to Holy Mother Saratha Devi. Prof.M.P.Patil, the Principal of College of Education, delivered the welcome address and introduced the resource persons for the event, Dr.Vijay Tunte and Dr.H.B.Jadhav from Pratap College Amalner.

The resource persons delivered a key address on Indian Constitution Day, providing insights into the historical significance of the day and the role played by Dr. B.R. Ambedkar. Some of the key highlights from their speeches included: The Government of India declared November 26 as Constitution Day in 2015 to honor the 131st birth anniversary of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar, the chief architect of the Indian Constitution.

Previously, this day was celebrated as Law Day and was later rebranded as Constitution Day to emphasize the importance of the constitution. The Constituent Assembly, which drafted the Constitution, held its first session on December 9, 1946, and it took almost three years to finalize the document. The "Objectives Resolution" presented by Jawaharlal Nehru was unanimously adopted as the Preamble on January 22, 1947. The Constitution of India was adopted on November 26, 1949, and came into effect on January 26, 1950.

Barakha Shitalkumar Samanpure, a first-year B.Ed. student-teacher, delivered a speech on Indian Constitution Day, offering insights into its historical significance. Following this, the faculty members and first-year B.Ed. student-teachers actively participated in the program.

Prof.N.D.Valhe IQAC coordinator, delivered the vote of thanks at the end of the session, expressing gratitude to all participants and resource persons. The program concluded with the singing of the National Anthem.

Outcomes:

- The programme raised awareness of Constitution Day's historical significance and Dr. B.R. Ambedkar's contribution to the Indian Constitution.
- The occasion turned Constitution Day into a significant educational observance by highlighting its historical significance in forming India's legal system and democratic system.
